

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy describes what personal data we process. It also clarifies how we store and use collected data, as well as the purpose for which it is retained.

According to GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation), personal data is defined as any information that can be directly or indirectly linked to an identified or identifiable natural person.

Personal Data We May Process

The personal data we may process includes:

- Name
- Phone number
- Email addresses containing personal information, for example, `firstname.lastname@company.com`

In cases where contact is established and information is exchanged via email, details included in such exchanges may also be saved. You are responsible for providing your personal data in the contact form.

How Personal Data Is Processed

The personal data that is saved will primarily be stored on local hard drives. We retain this personal data as long as we find it necessary to achieve the purpose of the collection.

In addition to personal data, we may also save other information you send us, either through the contact form or otherwise, such as email. However, this data will only be retained to the extent we deem it relevant and in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

If you provide personal data belonging to someone other than yourself, you must first obtain that person's consent. You are responsible for ensuring that the personal data provided is accurate and relevant for contacting us. We will only retain information that we deem necessary.

Disclosure of Personal Data

To the extent we find it necessary, we will share the personal data we retain with third parties. For example, personal data may be shared with subcontractors for mastering of audio files.

We may also disclose personal data to our representatives, insurance companies, or professional advisors if deemed necessary, but in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Additionally, we may disclose personal data to the extent we are required to by law, for example, at the request of a court or competent authority.
